Before you do that, I'd love to see some of the results!

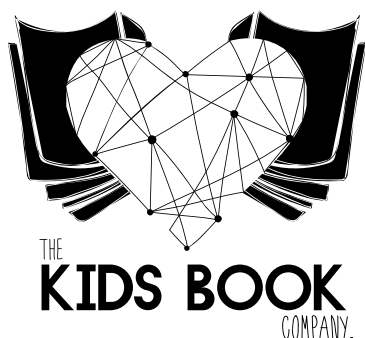

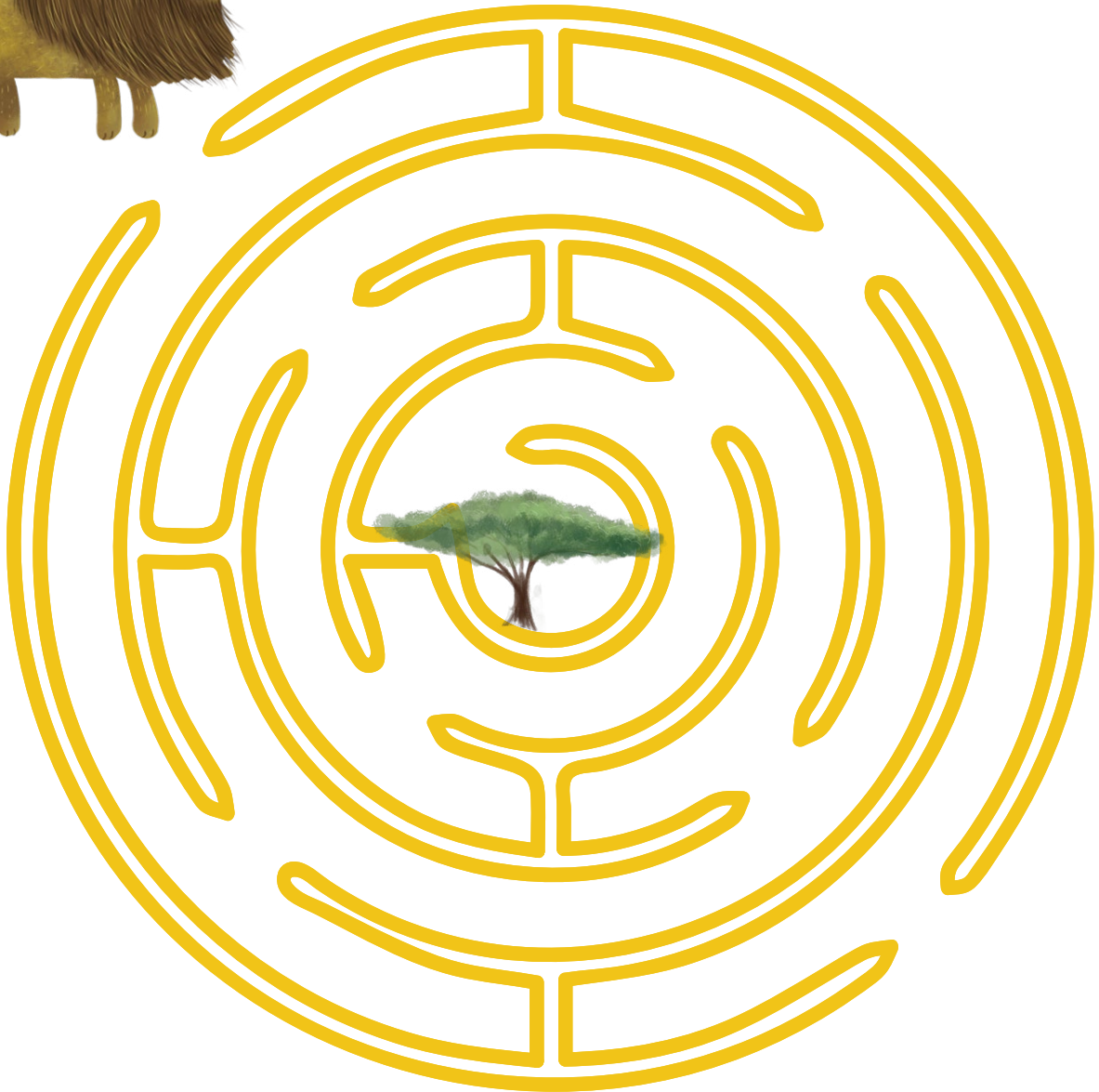

Often we think that lions live in dens, but African lions actually live under shady trees! It's only when a lioness wants to give birth to her cubs does she find a den or lair.



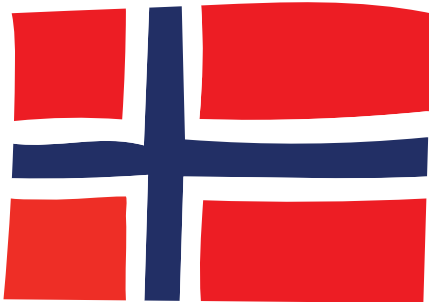

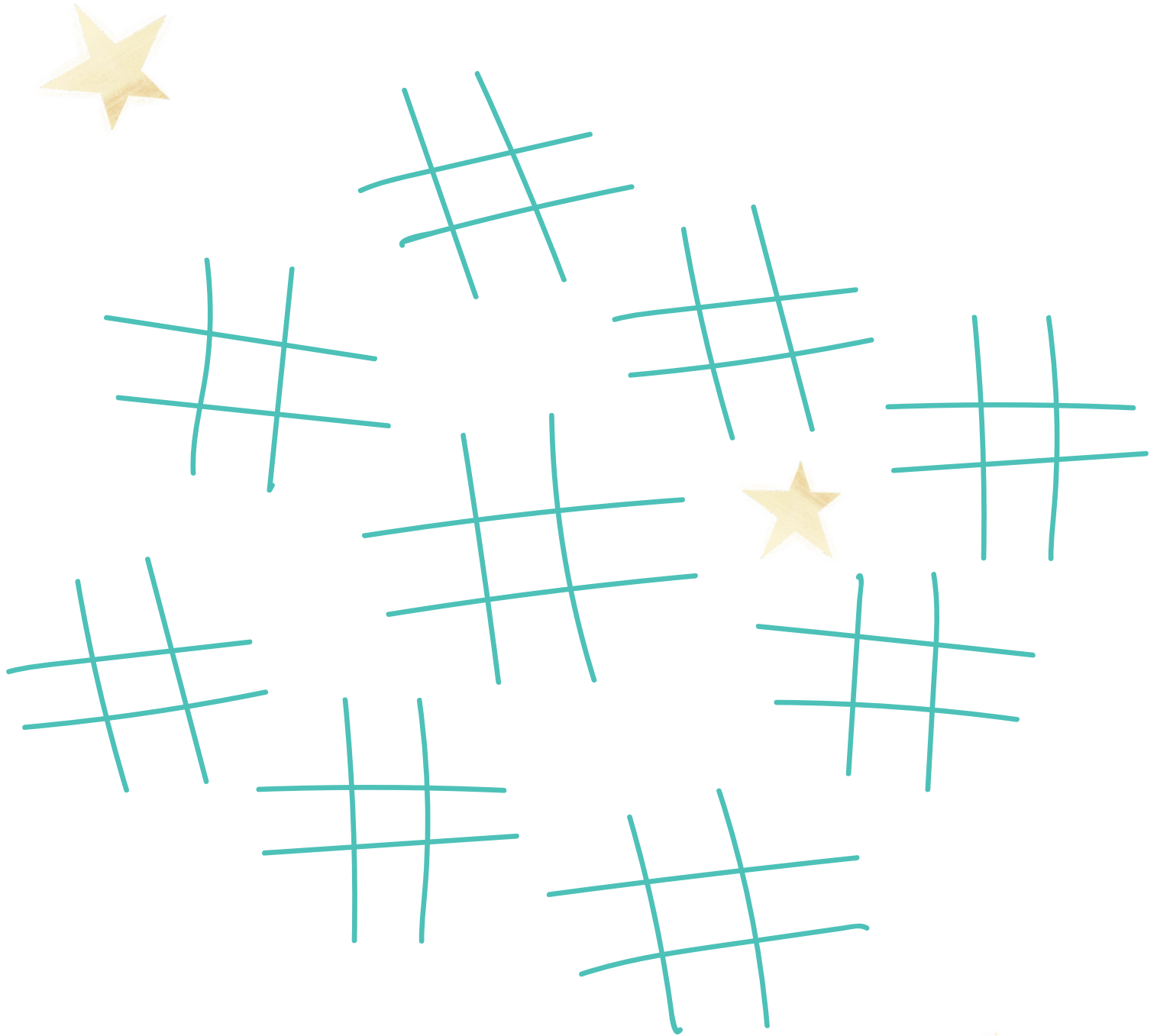
DID YOU KNOW?

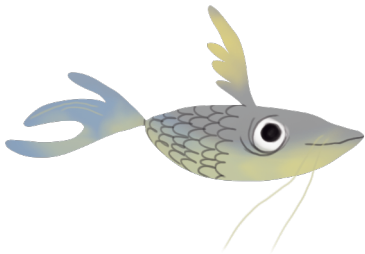

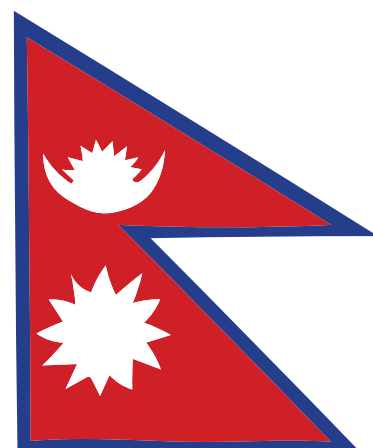

They can be combined to make bigger numbers!

It works like this, here's 27:

$$X + X + V + II = XXVII$$

$$10 + 10 + 5 + 2 = 27!$$

Or, here's 156!

$$C + L + VI = CLVI$$

$$100 + 50 + 6 = 156!$$

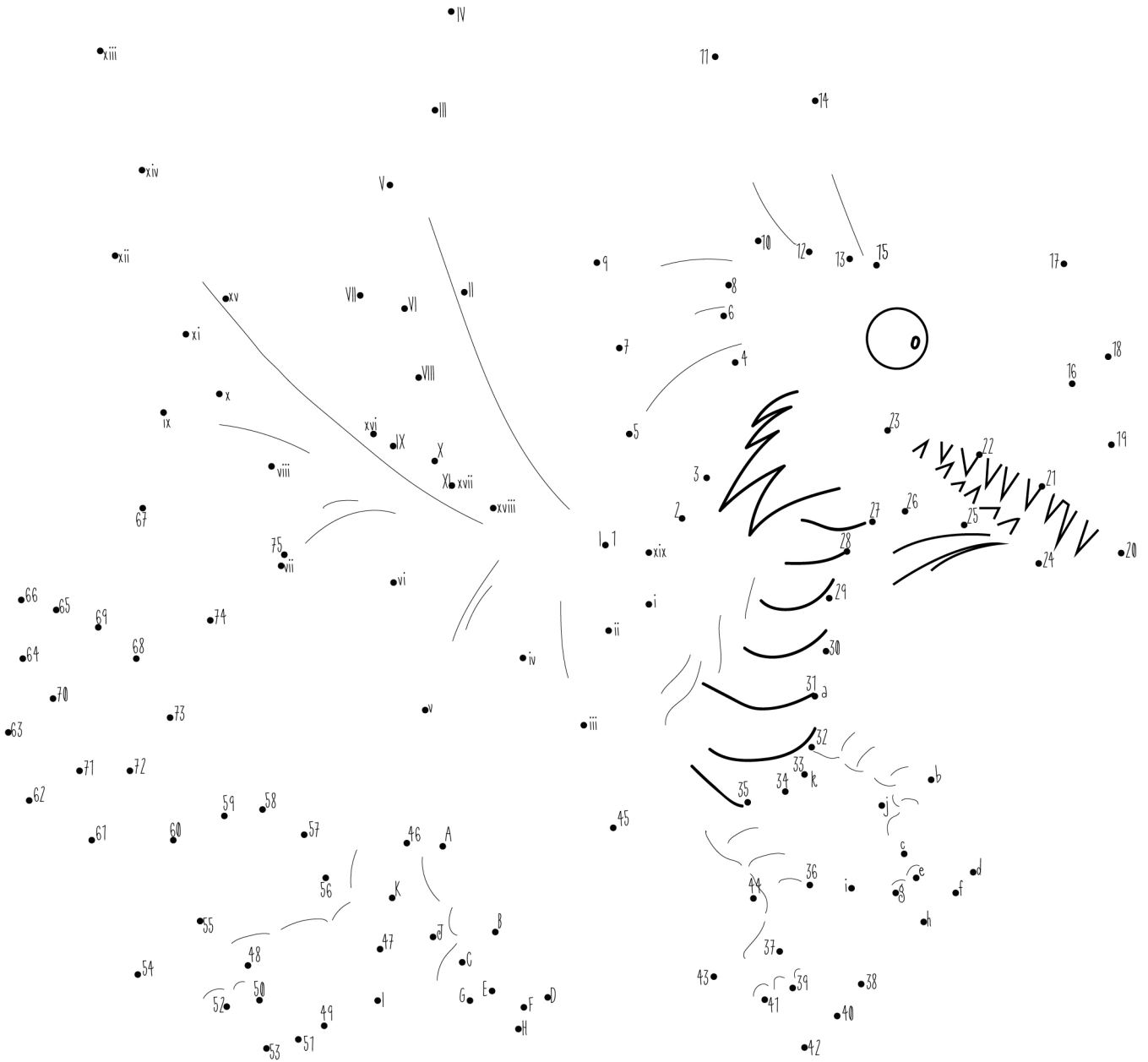

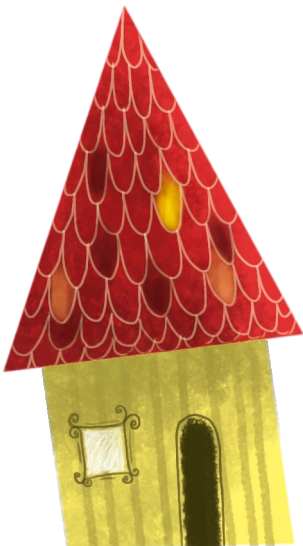

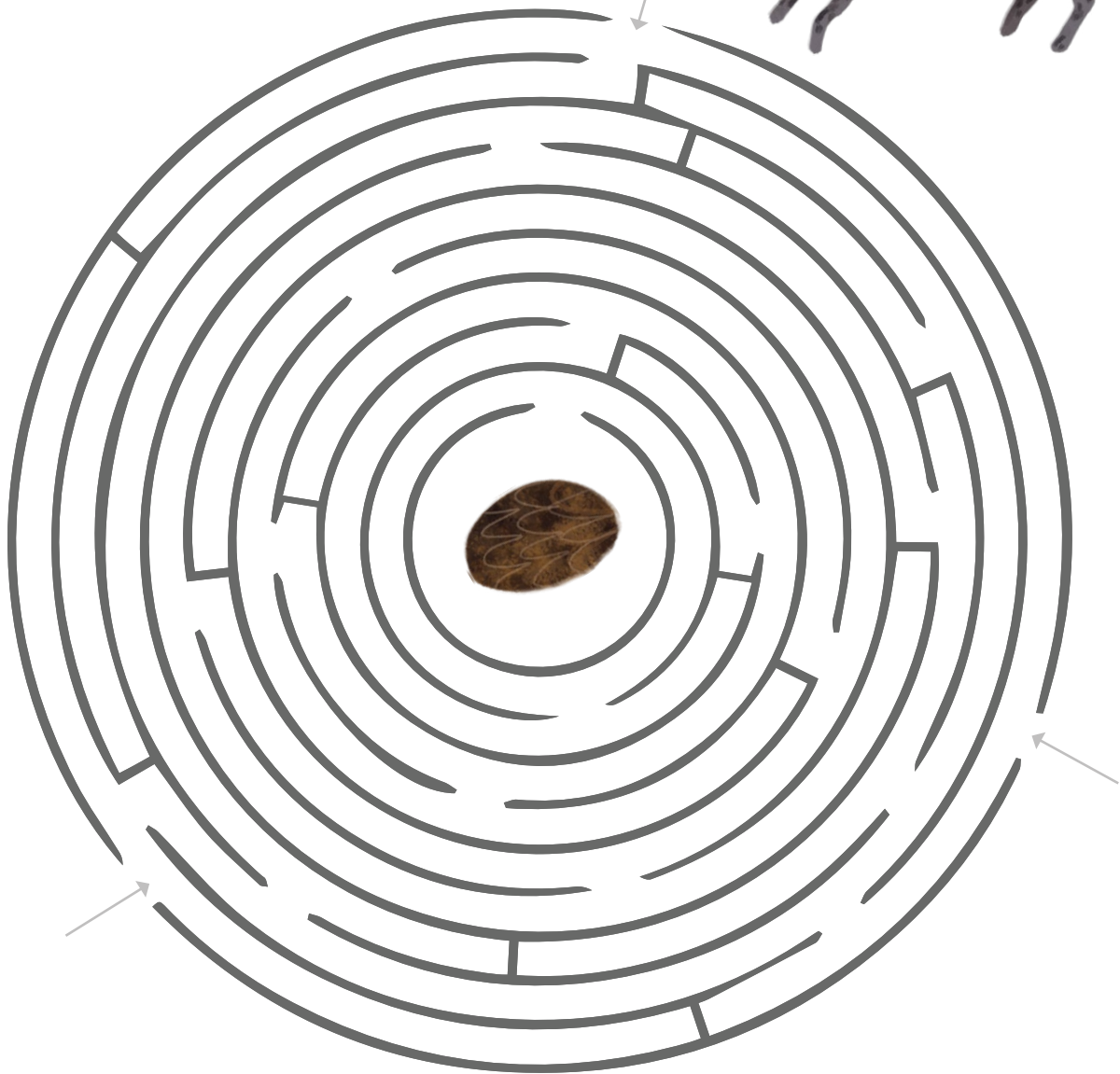


DID YOU KNOW?

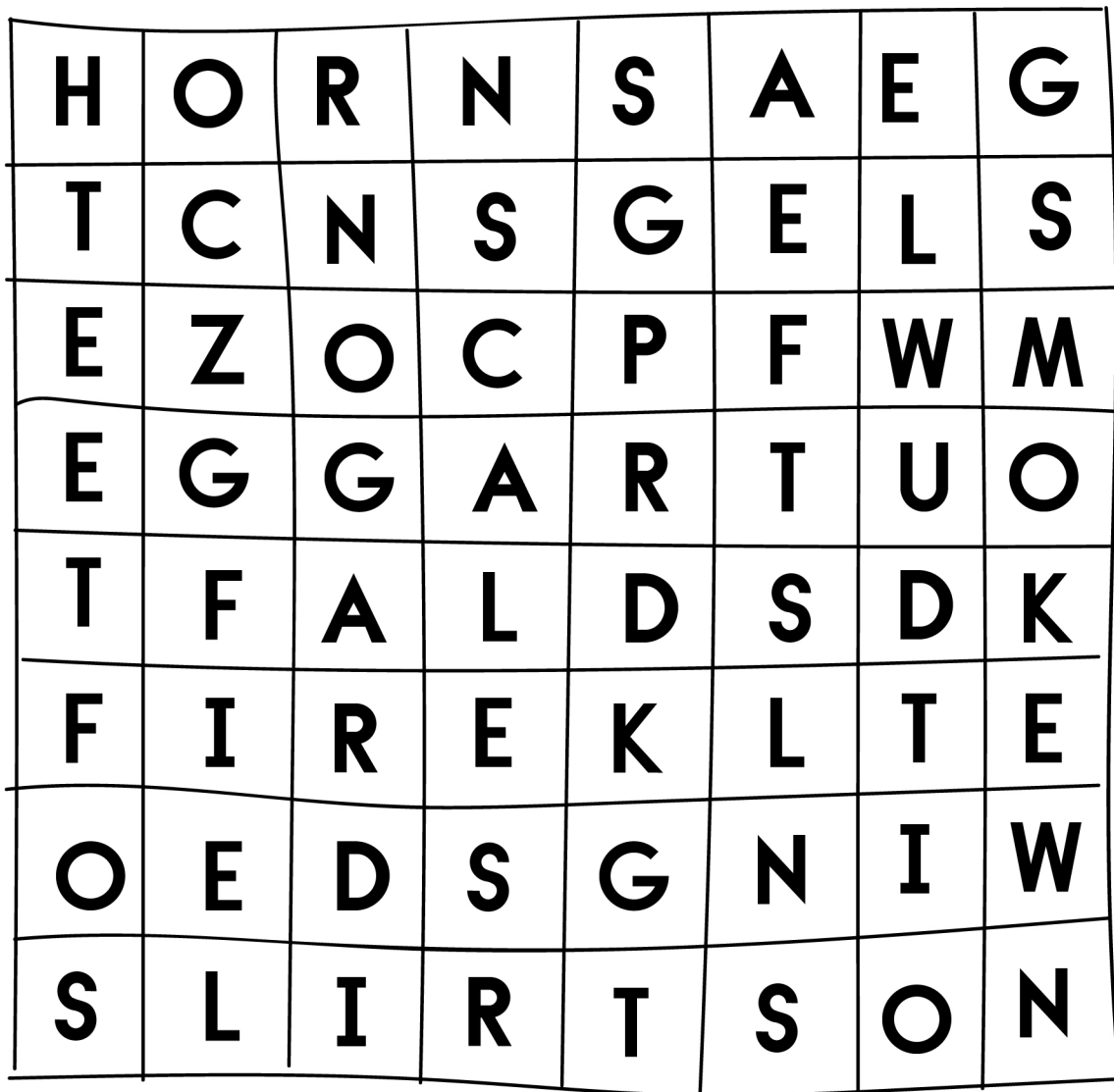

The Ohrid trout, which lives in Lake Ohrid is a 'living fossil' - it survived the ice age, but sadly is now in danger of becoming extinct!

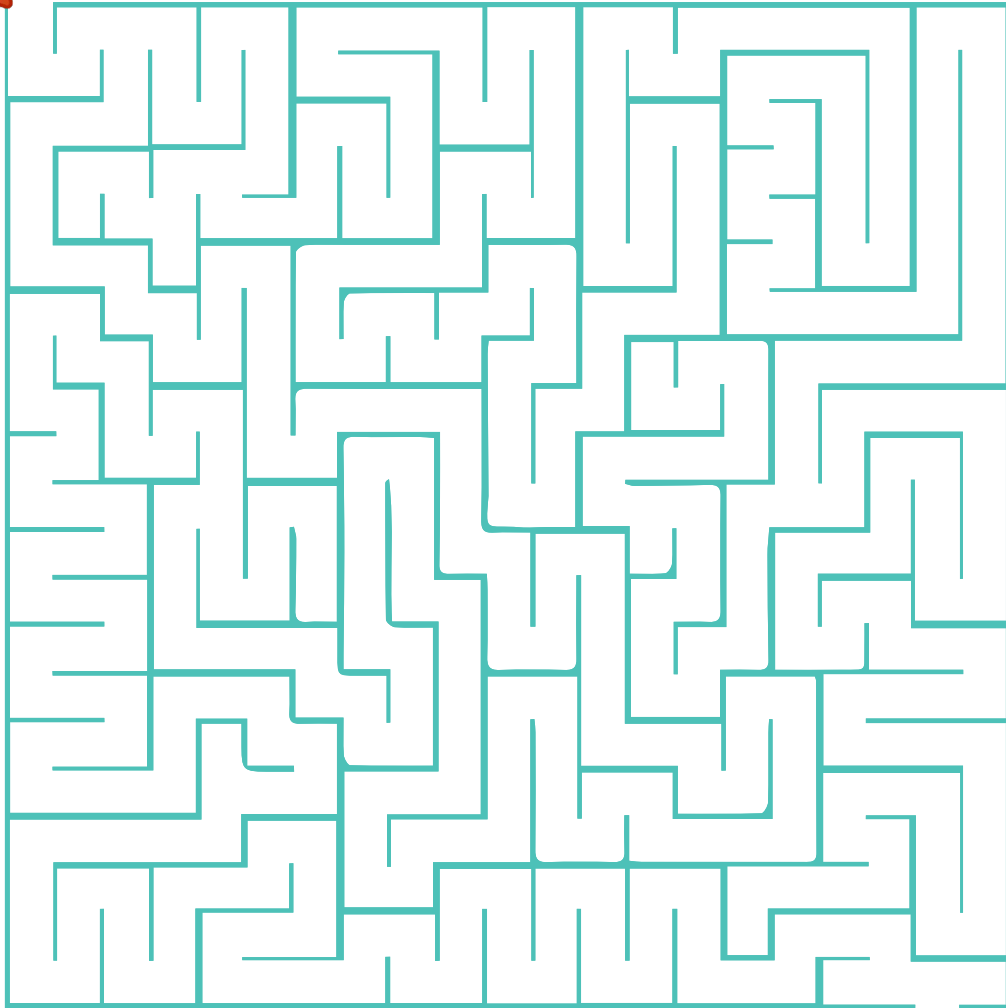

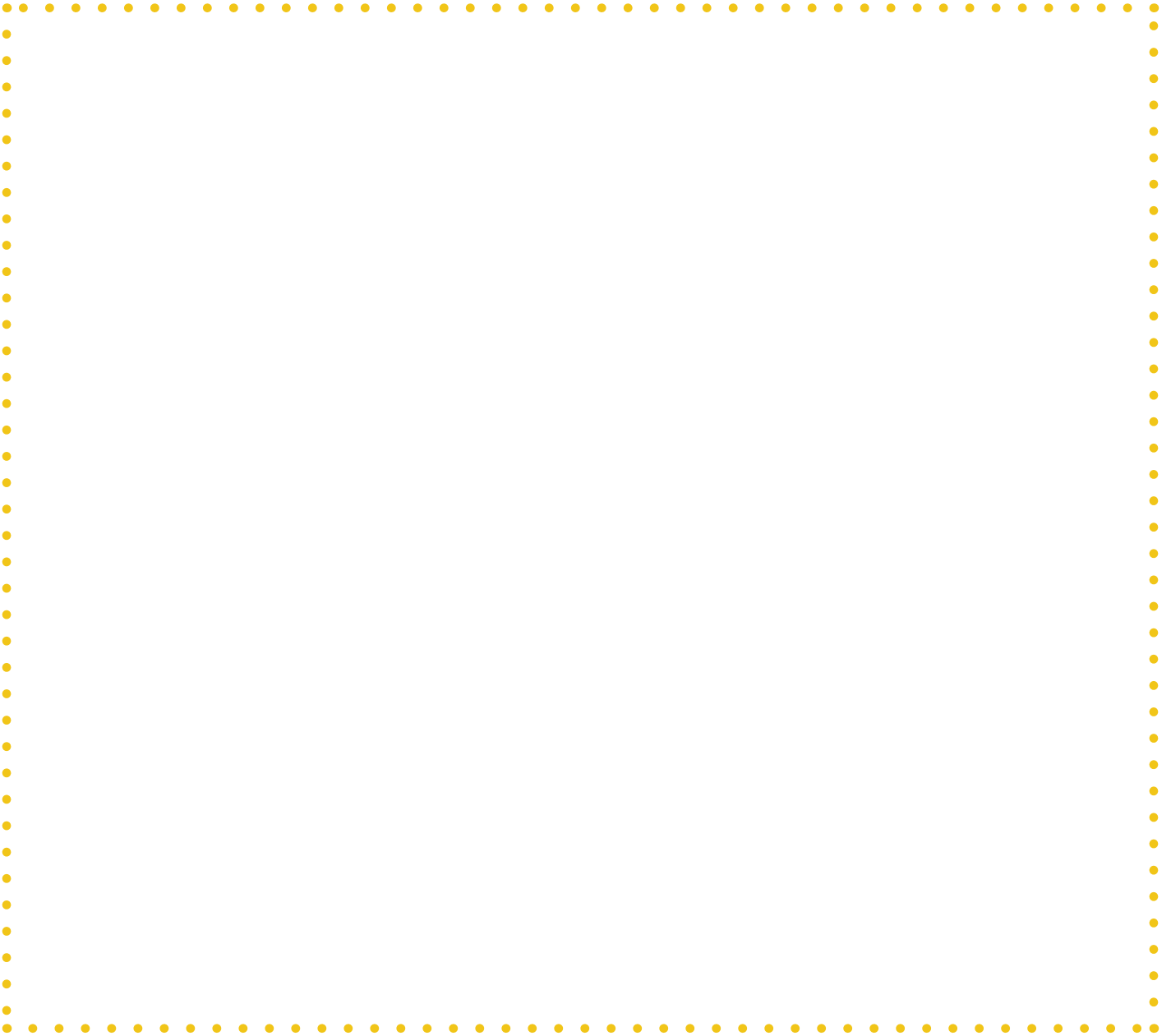


DID YOU KNOW?
