




HELP THE LION FIND HIS **WAY HOME!**




Often we think that lions live in dens, but African lions actually live under shady trees! It's only when a lioness wants to give birth to her cubs does she find a den or lair.


Elephants have poor eyesight but an AMAZING sense of smell. And their skin is an inch (2.5cm) thick!




In Greek, the word 'squirrel' means 'shadow tail'.


The Bagobo tribe in the Philippines lived in tree houses, which kept them safe from snakes, dangerous animals and enemies.


The Ohrid trout, which lives in Lake Ohrid is a 'living fossil' - it survived the ice age, but sadly is now in danger of becoming extinct!


